# OFFICIAL NOTICE Special Vote at the January 2004 Meeting

During the January 7<sup>th</sup> Membership Meeting, the following changes to the By-Laws will be voted on. The recommended changes are highlighted below. Items to be deleted are <u>underlined</u>. Items to be added are in **bold**.

#### Section 5.1.1

The ten Directors shall consist of: The immediate past President as Director at Large, the Director of Training (if he/she is member of the Club), the Assistant Director of Training, the Graduation Chairperson, the Waggin' Tales Editor, the **Obedience** Trial Chairperson, the **Obedience** Trial Secretary, the Membership Chairperson, the Tracking **Test** Chairperson, and the Public Education Liaison, and the **Agility Trial** Chairperson.

#### Section 5.3.1

The duties of the Board shall be to determine policies of the Club and to make all necessary decisions not covered by these By-Laws. A quorum shall consist of at least <u>five (5)</u> **seven (7)** members excluding the President.

#### Section 6.1

Election shall be at the annual meeting, at which time the President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Director of Training, <u>Graduation Chairperson</u>, Waggin' Tales Editor, **Obedience** Trial Chairperson, **Obedience** Trial Secretary, Membership Chairperson, Tracking **Test** Chairperson, Public Education Liaison, **Agility Trial Chairperson** and Member or Members-at-large will be elected.

Board Meeting Highlights December 3, 2003

Meeting brought to order at 7:41 p.m.

Carolyn Pearson (Secretary), the August Meeting Minutes approved as published. One correspondence item was read.

Cindy Pakenas (Director of Training) reported that the quest for 2004 instructors has begun. Beginning in January 2004, the following changes will be made:

- Nadine Conner will teach the 7:00 p.m. Novice Ring-Ready class
- Will Short will teach the 7:00 p.m. Advanced Beginner's class

These changes mean that Cindy is in need of a person to do the Utility Run-Throughs. Anyone interested in doing the utility run-throughs should contact Cindy, at 815-827-4317 or DOT@fvdtc.org, or Penny Brcich, at 630-980-0881 or ADOT@fvdtc.org.

Cindy also reported that she received good feedback from the instructors at the December 2<sup>nd</sup> Instructor's workshop. She said that she would like to do the workshops on a quarterly basis and perhaps at different locations. Cindy will

Will Short (Obedience Trial Chairperson) reported that he and Taffy have already begun working on the 2004 trial.

Taffy Wille (Obedience Trial Secretary) reported that she is working with AKC about the changing the date that AKC has scheduled for our 2004 trial. That date is the weekend that the Kane County Flea Market is at the Kane County Fairgrounds. She is also trying to get confirmation from the Kane County Fairgrounds that the fairgrounds are available on November 14<sup>th</sup>.

Dave Lewis (Waggin' Tales Editor) stated that he has renewed the domain name for the next two years. The next deadline for Waggin' Tales is December 7th.

Amy Ford (Treasurer) was not in attendance, but sent the following report.

- Please submit to her, all check requests and/or cash receipts for 2003 by December 23, so the 2003 yearend financial statements can be prepared for the January Membership Meeting.
- She also reported that she is planning to prepare a budget for 2004, so she will be contacting various people in December to help her make some estimates. She says "You can run, but you cannot hide!"

Barb Misch (Public Education Coordinator) reported that the WOOF-line was updated. She also stated that the Wrap and Read FUNdraiser at Barnes and Nobles on Friday, November 28th only raised \$43.38. The next date is Saturday, December 13<sup>th</sup> and she is still in need of Readers from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

The next CGC test is scheduled for January 15, 2004. She stated that anyone who had been on the waiting list for the September 18<sup>th</sup> test have been notified of the next date and will receive priority for taking the test in January. Those individuals must provide confirmation by the deadline. After that date, the remaining slots will be opened to others interested in taking the test.

#### **Old Business**

• Land/Building Committee Report - Helen Castellano reported that she, Francene Andresen, and Barb Misch met with attorneys, Tom Gosselin and John Gosselin for an exploratory meeting. The one-and-half hour meeting was used to explain to the attorneys our plans for the property. The next step for us is to provide the attorneys with a copy of our by-laws and our articles of incorporation. John Gosselin will contact the county to get more information about the property. We also need to get a flood assessment, after receiving permission from the properties sellers to access the property.

Francene stated that she was concerned that these lawyers did not provide her with the feeling that they would be able to guide us well during this process. Helen stated that an exploratory meeting was simply a way for the attorneys to determine what our goals are, not a meeting to provide us with the steps to be followed. Helen agreed to contact the attorneys to ask for an estimate of the cost to us for the land purchase process and whether they would be able to walk us through this process.

The Board members stated that we really do need to have someone who is experienced guide us through this process, such as who would be able to perform the flood assessment. It was also suggested that the realtor, Dennis, might be able to find someone to do the flood assessment.

Carolyn agreed to check with Amy Ford about our charter and articles of incorporation. The board members want to be certain that the board members are not personally financially responsible for the land purchase process. A copy of whatever paperwork that is responsible for our existence will be sent to Helen Castellano.

Francene reported that she did view the property today to see what it looked like without the corn plants. She stated that although she did not physically walk the property, in her opinion, the property is appropriate for our needs. She also reported that she was told that this was the first year that there was water in the middle of the property during rainstorms.

Tracey Mohr repeated her suggestion that we contact someone who is a buyer's agent. She stated that we might be able to save money by allowing the buyer's agent to do some of the work that the attorneys would charge \$150 per

hour to do. Francene stated that she would check on finding a buyer's agent.

#### New Business

• Health Certificates For Current Members - Carolyn Pearson and Sue MacPherson addressed this issue. They felt that if the club requires our Puppy and Beginner students to provide a Health Certificate, we should require that the current club members also provide some type of proof of health. Sue stated that as a person who works in a vet's office, she sees many dogs coming in that put other dogs at risk for contagious diseases, such as coronavirus. Given the large number of dogs that enter the training facility, she feels that the dogs at training are in a high-risk environment.

Although, there are many other communicable diseases that dog owners should consider protecting their dogs against, legally, we can only require proof of a rabies vaccination. Since it was assumed that club members are responsible dog owners, we must assume that all dogs that are brought into the training facility are properly protected.

Another aspect of this issue was how to keep track of the dog's health certificate. This would be difficult because many of our club members purchase and administer their own vaccinations. Additionally, we discussed the dogs that are being fostered by our club members. It was stated that many rescue organizations are not able to provide the foster home with any type of reliable health records. Nor can they afford to pay for the dogs to be vaccinated prior to permanent adoption.

Taffy stated that she felt that by requiring the Puppy and Beginner's students to provide a Health Certificate, we are helping new dog owners to initiate a valuable relationship between the new dog owner and their vet. Cindy Pakenas stated that Puppy students do not have to provide a new Health Certificate for the Beginner's class.

• **CERF Clinic.** Trudi Kimm provided the following information from Dr. Paul Gerding from U of I in Champaign. He and his staff are willing to do a CERF Clinic for us in March or April. Their basic rate is \$600.00 plus \$1.00 per form that they have to send in. We still

need to confirm with Dr. Gerding and his staff the hours that they are available. Once a date and the times are confirmed, information will be announced to the club members. It was agreed that we should charge \$15.00 per dog.

- Taffy requested that she be allowed to purchase 25 more copies of the Shelby Marlo books. The Board approved the request.
- Peggy Sue Seehafer reported that she has noticed a lot of business cards being left at the St. Charles Park District's Dog Park on Campton Hills Road. She presented the idea of asking the Park District whether we could place some sort of permanent sign at the dog park for advertising our club and training classes. It was the consensus of the Board members that this would be an excellent way to advertise and promote better trained dogs at the dog park. Peggy Sue and Carolyn will send a letter to the park district asking for permission to post a sign.
- Cindy Pakenas requested permission to purchase a couple of bottles of Direct Stop repellent spray. This spray will be available to use by instructors should a dog become aggressive and will be kept in the First Aid box in the equipment closet.

A motion was made, seconded and approved to adjourn the meeting at 9:25 p.m.

## IT'S AWARDS TIME 2003!!

It is the policy of FVDTC to give awards for AKC, CKC and UKC titles earned at trials, tests or shows each year. Below is a list of the awards that are offered and a copy of the forms we will be using this year. Each form must contain all the information for eligibility. Please submit one handler form and a separate form for each dog.

If for some reason you have not met **ALL** your requirements (i.e. attended three membership meetings, worked at what equals six work credits and actively participated in the training of dogs at the club) and can justify the reason, your eligibility will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. We highly suggest that if three meetings were not attended, that there is a compensating work effort shown.

Awards are given for titles earned in 2003 (i.e., a dog may have earned two "legs" toward a title prior to 2003, but if the third "leg" was earned in 2003, the title is earned in 2003). However, all scores for any of the "Special Club Awards" must have been earned in 2003.

Members owning mixed breed dogs are eligible for a Certificate of Merit for the equivalent of AKC titles earned at **MATCHES**. Submit at least 3 qualifying score sheets signed by three different judges. This also applies to purebred dogs that are not registered by the AKC.

Any award that states "Personalized" will be engraved with the dog's name, title and year. PLEASE NOTE: Anyone wishing to receive an award that requires your dog's picture or involves having your dog's photo taken or other personalized artwork produced - please get everything submitted as soon as possible. All submitted pictures **MUST** be <u>clear</u>, <u>close-up photos</u> for best reproduction. Our artists need time to work on these, so please be considerate.

Front and Finish is now offering the "Front and Finish Excellent (FFX) Obedience Platinum Award". The requirements are that the obedience title must be completed in three trials with scores of 195 or better. If you are eligible for this award, **you must also submit the FFX Application with the rest of your forms**. #### SPECIAL CLUB AWARDS

ALL scores for special awards must have been earned in the current year and must have been earned at AKC trials unless otherwise specified.

**NOVICE A - HIGH QUALIFYING AVERAGE AWARD** - must have a minimum of 3 scores from AKC trials submitted.

**NOVICE B - HIGH QUALIFYING AVERAGE AWARD** - must have a minimum of 3 scores from AKC trials submitted.

**OPEN - HIGH QUALIFYING AVERAGE AWARD** - must have a minimum of 3 scores from AKC trials submitted.

**UTILITY - HIGH QUALIFYING AVERAGE AWARD**, must have a minimum of 3 scores from AKC trials submitted.

**NOTE: ALL** qualifying **AND** non-qualifying scores must be submitted if you are applying for one of the following special awards that refer to an "average" score. If you do not know your NQ score, list it as 165. Remember, obedience is a sport guided by the principles of good sportsmanship. Each of you is on the "honor system" in submitting your scores.

**DOROTHY DIMOND MEMORIAL TROPHY** - given to the member whose dog was trained & shown by the member & receives the highest average score in regular classes in at least three AKC trials. All scores must be included. NQ's, unless higher, will be 165.

**DEBBIE ORR MEMORIAL AWARD** - goes to the member whose dog or dogs earned the most AKC titles or international equivalents during the year. For this award, AKC, UKC and CKC titles are counted.

**HEATHER MEMORIAL AWARD** - offered by Nancy Gillum, in memory of Briarwood's Heather Miss AM/CAN CD. It is given to the handler whose dog earned the 3 highest scores in Novice A at AKC trials.

**FOUNDERS AWARD** - offered by Fox Valley Dog Training Club, Inc. in memory of the founders of FVDTC. It is given to the handler whose dog earned the 3 highest scores in regular classes at AKC trials.

**ED KNEIP AWARD** - given to the handler whose dog earned the highest combined score in Open B <u>and</u> Utility A or B at same AKC trial.

**KANOSAK KENNEL AWARD** - given to the handler whose dog earned the 3 highest Utility A scores at AKC trials with at least 5 scores being submitted.

**SALLY COMPTON OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE CLUB AWARD** - given to a club member to acknowledge them and their contributions to the club. This award is especially significant because it offers you the opportunity to nominate a fellow club member for their efforts. Because the nominations are reviewed by the Board to determine the winner, no current Board member is eligible.

THE ABOVE SPECIAL AWARDS WILL BE KEPT FOR ONE YEAR BY THE WINNER AND REPLACED BY A PERMANENT REPLICA.


