Air Conditioning Unit Will Be ON at Training This Week!

Good news regarding the new air conditioning unit in our training building! Its operable and its fabulous! Due to the financial impact of this luxury, a motion was made, considered by the board and passed.

The motion was as follows:

Air Conditioning for training nights will be utilized when the forecast is to be over 85 degrees. The process would be that the DOT checks the weather forecast the day before (usually Wednesday) training and makes the call if the AC will be on. If the forecast meets the threshold the DOT would contact the web master to post it on the FVDTC Web site and Facebook page and call the Fairgrounds to ask that it be turned on for training. This would need to be done by end of business, the day before a training session.

The Fairgrounds will bill FVDTC \$250 per use and will bill us quarterly. This motion is for the year of 2012 and to include the use of a maximum of 10 instances (for a total of \$2500).

Please note that there are still some details to be hammered out regarding this topic including how negotiable the cost is when considering our upcoming contract with the fairgrounds.

Also, it appears that the board is wavering a little on the threshold temperature. 85 degrees or 90 degrees.

Please email me your opinions; I want to hear from you. I talked to a lot of you at training last week about this and although you "hired" us, the board, to make decisions on your behalf, it's my opinion that YOUR thoughts are the ones that really matter. Many of you expressed that you would expect the costs of this luxury to be a part of the dues you pay. Others said they would come to training regardless of the temperature.

Regardless, the installation of the AC unit is good news all around!

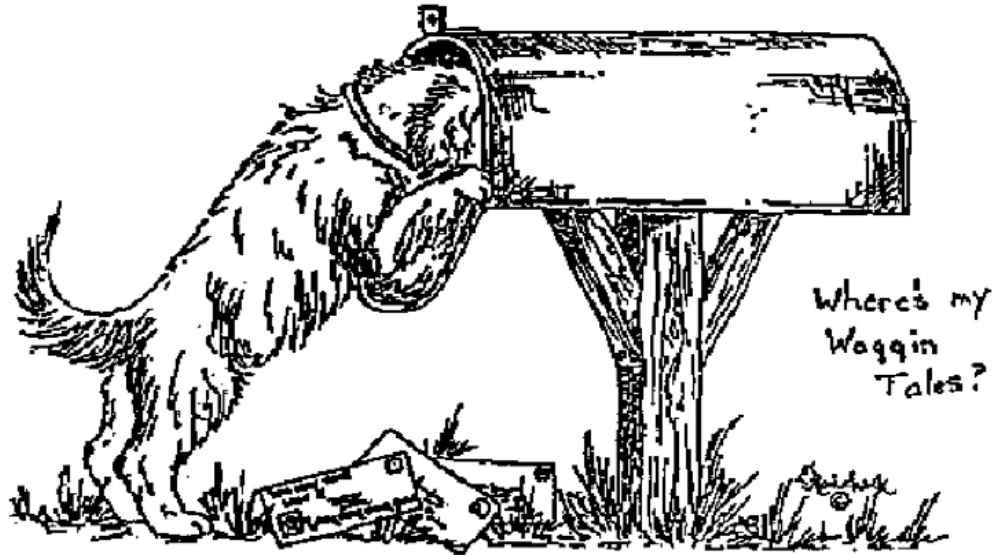
Meeting Minutes
