Beginner Novice A, Novice A, and Rally Novice A Goodie Bags

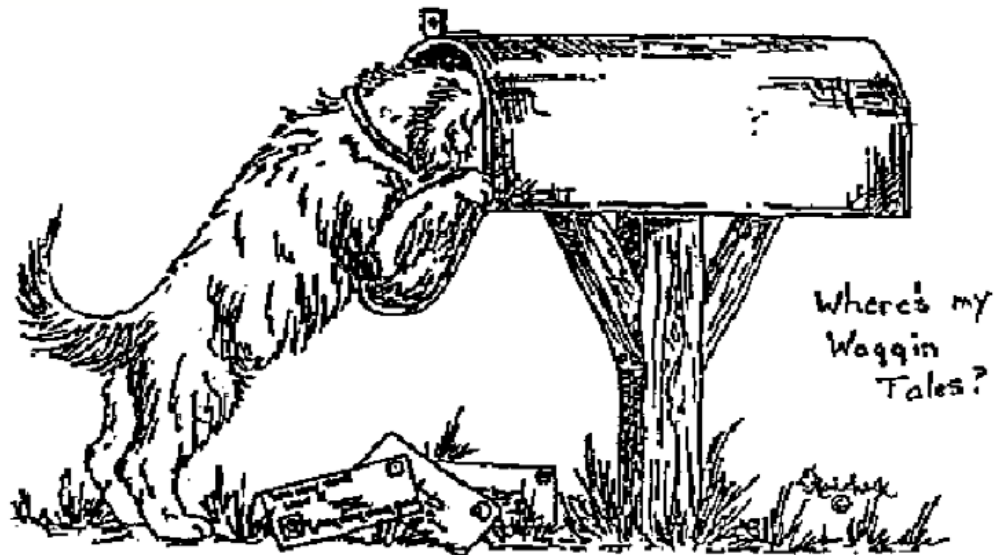
