## **New Rules for Flying**

The Department of Transportation has changed the rules for flying with your pet. Flying with a service animal is generally free, but the DOT changed the definition of a "service animal" to a "a dog ... that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of a qualified individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability." Certification is required, and documents must be provided to the airline. Alaska Airlines and American airlines have changed their policies to match the new rules.


