### We're Back!

Now that Region 8; which includes Kane County; is in Tier 1 mitigations; FVDTC will be able to reopen. But we are only allowed to have 25 people or fewer in the building. So, we will resume the same plan we had in November, right before we closed last. This means class sizes will be limited and there will be no run through classes with instructors to allow enough spots for our paid classes and some training spots.

Signup for training spots and classes is open now, starting with instructors only on Saturdays, then members on Sundays and then Guests on Mondays, open for all members. In order to sign up you must be listed as a training member for 2021. That means your membership renewal and dues for 2021 must be up to date at the time of signing up. If you have sent in your renewal as a non-training member for 2021, you will need to pay your dues fees in order to return to training.

IMPORTANT ENTRANCE INFORMATION....Due to vaccine clinics that are being held at the Fairgrounds several days a week, including on Thursdays, the front entrance gates on Randall Road will be locked so no access will be available at the front entrance. Everyone will need to use the back entrance to the fairgrounds and enter at the Oak Street entrance.

We have one new addition to our Board this year, Gina Post, who is our new Public Education Coordinator. Welcome, Gina!

I would like to thank all the Committee Chairpersons who volunteered in 2020 and again in 2021. Also, a big

thank you to everyone that volunteered in any way to help your club last year. FVDTC is such a great club because of all our dedicated and wonderful volunteers. Thank you all!

I would also really like to thank every member of the 2020 Board. 2020 was a very difficult year due to the numerous complications that were caused by the COVID-19 virus. We had to make a lot of difficult decisions in order to keep everyone as safe as possible, while still adhering to the Governor's orders and the guidelines of the CDC. There were many discussions via Zoom meetings, phone calls and more emails then I could possibly count. Thank you all for your hard work and dedication to FVDTC and all of our members. Let's hope that 2021 will be a much better year!

I wanted to update everyone about our Awards for New Titles, Volunteer Awards and our Special Awards for 2020. Since we still don't know when we can resume normal activities, it has been decided to cancel 2021 Annual Dinner. Therefore, all Awards for 2020 will be awarded along with the 2021 Awards at our Annual Dinner in 2022. However, to ensure there is no confusion, everyone who qualified for a New Title, Special Award or Volunteer Award in 2020 will need to fill out the Awards now. All 2020 Awards forms need to be mailed or emailed to Sally Boeke by April 1, 2020, no exceptions. The 2020 Awards forms are published in this newsletter and are available on the web site. Since the club was closed for a large part of 2020, we have lowered the number of Work Credits that are required for all the 2020 Awards. Instead of the usual 10 Work Credits, you only need 5 Work Credits for the 2020 Awards. If you have earned any New Titles in 2020, but don't have the required 5 Work Credits, you may submit a hardship request to the Board. Each case will be decided on a case by case basis. Also, the Awards Committee will soon be taking Nominations for the 2020 Sally Compton and Rookie of the Year Awards. We will also do the voting for these two Awards soon. So, think about the club members you would like to nominate for these awards.

And the news that we have been waiting for since November has arrived; we are scheduled to reopen for classes and training on February 4<sup>th</sup>! Here is a brief synopsis of how we finally got here from November, 2020. According to the Governor's 5 Phase Restore Illinois Plan, Illinois is divided into 11 different regions; Kane and DuPage counties are region 8. Within each Phase of the Plan, there are 3 Tier mitigations. When we closed in November, the state was in Tier 2 which only allowed a maximum of 10 individuals in training. Those restrictions don't allow us to hold classes or offer training. Recently, Region 8 hit all the required metrics to go to Tier 1 mitigations which allows for 25 people in the building, which – in turn – allows us reopen. Updates will be available on the web site, our Facebook page and in your email, if you have signed up for the club's email blasts.

One last thing, it's Membership Renewal time! Please send in your completed renewal forms and dues payment to Sue MacPherson ASAP. Don't forget to mark "Regular Training" on the application if intend to train, now that we are re-opening on February 4. Due to the past multiple closures, and event cancelations we have waived the Work Credit requirements for your dues reduction. Everyone qualifies for the 50% dues reduction this year.

#### *IT'S A WARDS TIME 2020!*

**Congratulations**! If you are filling out award forms then you must have earned one or more new titles in 2020! It is the policy of FVDTC to give awards for AKC, CKC and UKC titles earned at trials, tests or shows each year. To receive a club award, you must have a total of **5** work credits for the year and be listed as a Regular Training Member in the Roster. If for some reason you have not met **ALL** your requirements and can justify the reason, your eligibility will be reviewed by the Board of Directors.

Contained is this packet is a form for individual awards, as well an application for the club's Special Awards. Please review each item in the following list before you begin.

- Each form must be completely filled out and **please print clearly** so we can read your information.
- Please submit **one** Family/Individual Work Credit Form plus **one** Award Application Form for **each** dog. If Spot and Fido each earned a title, then two Award Applications should be submitted with one Work Credit Form.
- Work credits can be earned by anyone in the family.
- A dog is limited to receiving one AKC award per level of titles received. For example, if your dog earns a CD and an RA, you may pick only one award at Level 2. The exception to this, is anyone who receives a title at the highest level in the same year (OTCH and a MACH).
- Awards are given for titles earned in 2020 (i.e., a dog may have earned two "legs" toward a title prior to 2020, but if the third "leg" was earned in 2020, the title is earned in 2020). However, all scores for any of the "Special Club Awards" must have been earned in 2020.
- Please print clearly on the 2020 FVDTC Annual Awards form. The Awards Committee wants your awards to be correct, so a clearly filled out form will help the committee achieve that goal.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

All photos submitted for an award MUST be <u>clear</u> and <u>close-up and should be emailed, actual prints are usually not</u> <u>necessary</u>. Airbrushed awards by Bill McGuffey require an article of clothing, which must be no less than 50% cotton and must be washed at least once. The clothing cannot have pleats, seams or sewn-in folds where the picture is to be painted. All of our artists need time to provide their best work, therefore the submission deadline will NOT be extended. PLEASE be considerate and meet or beat the deadline.




