As COVID conditions continue to evolve and change, we will continue to update our COVID-related policies, as we have been doing since the start of COVID. For now our mask mandate has not changed; all are still required to wear the proper masks while inside the building, regardless of your vaccination status. We continuing our mask requirements because we know there are members, students and guests that are susceptible to COVID and we don't track the vaccination status for our members, students or guests. The CDC has highly recommended that businesses and organizations that don't know the vaccination status of individuals should continue to require the wearing of masks indoors, especially in crowded areas.

However, now that we are in the "Bridge Phase" in Illinois, we are allowed higher capacities in the building. This means we will be able to increase our class sizes to 12 students during the next session. Our Ring Ready Class has already been increased to allow 12 students. We will also be able to allow guests to return to training. For the time being, we are still going to do online sign ups for our drop in classes and training spots. 
