*AKC Tracking\_Regulations*, Chapter 2, Section 8. Please keep bitches in season in your vehicle and notify the Test Secretary upon arrival.

Fox Valley Dog Training Club assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitor, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

The Tracking Test is for dogs not less than six months of age. With the entry form for the TD test of a dog, which has not passed a "Tracking Test", there must be filed a written statement by a person who is accredited by the American Kennel Club to judge a "Tracking Test", that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. The holding of other titles including "TD" shall not bar the dog from competition in the TD test. Entries without a Tracking Degree (TD) will be accepted first. There will be no actual scores for the TD or the TDX Test, but the dog will be rated "Passed" or "Failed" and a TD or TDX certificate will be issued by the American Kennel Club confirming all dogs rated "Passed".

Telegraph, telephone, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of *entry forms without the NEW Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form* are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. Check your old photocopied forms and update.

Entry fee for the TD test is \$75.00, and \$125.00 for the TDX (includes \$0.50 for AKC recording fee and \$3.00 for the AKC event service fee) made payable to Fox Valley Dog Training Club in US funds. A recording fee of \$0.50 and an event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, or obedience trial, or tracking test. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only. PLEASE RETURN ENTRY FORM WITH THE AGREEMENT PAGE AS WELL.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries close with the Tracking Secretary, Kent Hildebrand.

Bitches in season will be allowed to run in this test as allowed in AKC Tracking Rules, Chapter 2. In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations (AKC Rules, Chapter 1, Section 26a) entries in this TD/TDX test shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached.

The entry participation drawing will be held at the Tracking Secretary's home on August 26, 2021 at 7:00 pm, to determine which entries will participate in the tests. This drawing shall be given for dogs that have not earned the TD/TDX title. When the advertised limited has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preference set for above, shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the alternate list. The Tracking Secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw.

No refunds will be given except of an entry for a dog that:

- (1) withdraws because of having passed a test between the closing date and the date of the test and is replaced by an alternate, provided that such withdrawal notice is given to the secretary at least 48 hours prior to the test; or
- (2) an alternate that does not participate shall be refunded within 7 days following the test.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Tracking Secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by the position on the Alternate List, which of the alternates shall participate. The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

The Club will set aside tracks for test workers from previous tests, as defined and identified by the test giving club. Entries from workers are to be drawn first, up to the limits: One TD track, and One TDX Track.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

## Covid 19 Restrictions:

### General Practices

1. Clubs, official and participants are required to follow state and local guidelines that apply to the area where the event is held.
2. Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
3. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others. Clubs should provide masks if desired for officials, judges and volunteers.
4. Consider wearing disposable or washable gloves.
5. Have plenty of hand sanitizers placed for people to use.
6. Wash hands as frequently as possible. Have disinfecting spray at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
7. If you utilize portable toilets, please ask for a hand washing station to be delivered as well.
8. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
9. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
10. Avoid common use pens/pencils—bring your own.
11. Disinfect surfaces in common use areas as often as possible (tables, chairs, doorknobs, bathrooms etc.
12. Meals – No potlucks. Recommend supplying boxed for judges and volunteers. Hospitality areas should avoid community items such as salt and pepper shakers, condiments, creamers, etc. Participants should consider bringing their own lunches/drinks.
13. Parking areas – Park with Increased distance between vehicles, if possible.
14. These practices are subject to change by AKC or local authorities.
