Board Meeting Highlights August 7, 2002

Meeting brought to order at 7:48 p.m.

Secretary - Carolyn Pearson

The June Meeting Minutes were approved as published, without any corrections. Several items of correspondence read

Trudi Kimm (Director of Training) reported that Marietta Huber is offering an Agility handling class at 9:00 p.m. This class is for individuals who are currently enrolled in another agility class or actively showing in agility trials. Marietta will teach handlers some techniques for getting the dogs between obstacles, to "move out, to "get back", etc. This class is not to teach agility for novice agility handlers. The class will only be offered when training is on Thursday nights, not Tuesday nights. This class will open only to guest trainers AFTER all interested current club members have received

a "space" in the ring.

Trudi reported that the following volunteers are instructing and assisting for the current session.

Additionally, Trudi asked that current instructors keep "watch" for individuals would have potential to be assistant (and primary) instructors.


