## Correction Clinic Guidelines For Judges, Stewards \& All Volunteers

Thank you for volunteering at FVDTC's correction clinic. We truly appreciate all your hard work. These clinics offer handlers and their dogs a great opportunity to practice in a show like setting. We couldn't do this without you and all our wonderful volunteers. Thank you!

We have set up a few guidelines to ensure that our correction clinics run as smoothly as possible. Most importantly, please be respectful of your fellow club members and volunteers. If any issues do arise, please address them with the appropriate committee chair in a calm \& respectful manner, please refrain from heated conversations with each other. Remember, you are a representative of the Fox Valley Dog Training Club. What you do and say is a reflection of the club as a whole.

## STEWARDS

- Please arrive no later then 6:30pm and go to your assigned ring as quickly as possible, see Ingrid Hamburger to get your ring assignment.
- If you are a new volunteer, let the judge that you are assigned to know this so they can help instruct you as to what is required.


## JUDGES

- Please arrive no later then 6:30 pm to make sure your ring is set up and ready to go before the start of judging at 7:00 pm.
- Please run through any stewards before the start of the clinic at 7:00pm.
- All rally judges must arrive by $6: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ to ensure the rally course is set up and ready to
- You must stay at your assigned ring and help until the last dog has been judged. Please do not leave your assigned ring or go train your dog in another ring during regular judging.
- You are entitled to one free run-through, please try to make sure you run your dog thru before the start of the clinic at $7: 00 \mathrm{pm}$.
go before the start of the clinic at 7:00pm. There are course maps in the rally folder.
- For all judges ... Please help your fellow judges. If you complete judging in your ring and see that other judges are still judging, it is mandatory that you help. This can be done by bringing overflow entries into your ring to judge them, you can also do the stay exercises in your ring.

- Please arrive on time and no later then 6:30 pm to ensure we are ready and set to go at the start of judging at $7: 00 \mathrm{pm}$.

## for Membership and Awards

Effective January 1, 2015

To maintain reduced membership dues, you must:

- Earn one work credit, in your first year of membership
or
- Earn three work credits, in each year after your first year of membership

To receive a club award, you must:

- have a minimum of ten work credits for the year, automatically includes the work credits for dues. and
- be listed as a Regular or Lifetime Training Member in the roster

Each available "job" in the club has been assigned the following work credits:
ONE credit:

- Attend a membership meeting
- Steward one Kane County Fair 4-H Dog Show
- Steward one Correction Clinic
- Work the Information Table/Front Desk for two nights
- Work $1 / 2$ day at the Obedience Trial
- Work $1 / 2$ day at the Agility Trial
- "Substitute" as an Instructor or an Assistant Instructor for two nights
- Instructor for Conformation Class for two nights
- Work at an Event (not on the committee)

TWO credits:

- Judge one Kane County Fair 4-H Dog Show
- Judge one Correction Clinic (OR the monetary compensation - NOT both)
- Evaluator for one CGC Test
- Work Full day at the Mat Cleaning
- Work Full day at the Tracking Test
- Work Full day at the Obedience Trial
- Work Full day at the Agility Trial

THREE credits:

- *Primary Instructor or Assistant Instructor for 4-H Class for one year
- Serve on a Committee for one year

FOUR credits:

- *Primary Instructor for Advanced Classes for one quarter
- *Assistant Instructor for Advanced Classes for one quarter
- *Primary Instructor for Conformation Class for one quarter
- *Primary Instructor for Puppy or Beginner Class for one session
- *Assistant Instructor for Puppy or Beginner Class for one session
- Serve as Puppy/Beginner Class coordinator for one year
- Serve as a Board Member for one year
- Chairperson on a Committee for one year
- Serve as Kane County 4-H Coordinator for one year
- Serve as Kane County 4-H Dog Projects Superintendent for one year
* Instructors must be present for at least $75 \%$ of the classes to receive the work credit.

Work credits for other services to the club may be awarded by the Board on a per-event basis.
