Membership Meeting Highlights - March 14, 2018

Meeting brought to order at 7:40 p.m.

Carolyn Pearson (Secretary). The September Meeting minutes were approved as published. The November Meeting minutes were approved as published. One item of correspondence was read.

Phil Nuger (Treasurer) was not at the meeting, but sent the following report:

- Club net income for 2017 was \$7,725.14;
 - \$4,048.22 net operating income and
 - \$3,676.92 investment income.
- End of Year asset balance was \$241,464.15
 - \$148,145.55 in checking account and CDs at Old Second Bank
 - \$93,318.60 in Morgan Stanley Investment Account
- 2018 Year to Date revenue from operations is \$14,950, which is on pace with last year's performance.
- Phil recommended that no change in class fees, membership dues structure and similar revenue stream items is required at this time.
- 2018 YTD expenses are not tallied yet, as there are still pending awards invoices.
- Phil reported that spending is projected to remain at the approximately the same level year to year, and therefore, no dramatic change is presently required.
- Phil reported that in summary the club is operating as planned.

Will Short (Director of Training) asked for ideas of events to host at our 6:00 p.m. workshops. Several club members suggested that we have a local vet demonstrate some basic first aid techniques. Peggy reminded club members that the local Red Cross office does offer a class for Canine CPR and First Aid. It was also suggested that we host a workshop for the CGC Advanced titling class.

Will reported that a new class began last week. He stated that Bill Abrams is providing Preferred Novice / Beginner Novice run-throughs in the Utility ring.
