Board Meeting Highlights - August 14, 2019

Meeting brought to order at 7:41 p.m.

Carolyn Pearson (Secretary). The June Meeting minutes were not available for approval.

Phil Nuger (Treasurer) was not in attendance, but sent the financial reports to be distributed at the meeting.

Will Short (Director of Training) reported that air conditioning will not be on tomorrow. He stated that from 5:30 p.m. until 6:45 p.m., the Rally course set up will be an easy course; after 6:45 p.m., it will be more challenging. The Rally Seminar participants have been encouraged to participate. Will also reported that the next session of the Advanced Puppy class will be held at 6:00 p.m. instead of 8:00 p.m., to determine whether the 6:00 p.m. would be better for the students and whether there would be a higher retention rate of the students for the session.

Kristina Pomagier (Public Education Coordinator) was not in attendance, but reported that one more volunteer is needed for the September adoption event.

Pat Senne (Obedience Trial Chairperson) reported that the judging panel will be determined tonight after the Board meeting. Once the panel has been determined, the judging panel will be submitted to AKC for approval. Following AKC approval, the premium list can be updated, sent to Bob Olson and distributed. It was agreed that the instructions for completing the entry for Rally Team required a better explanation.

Dave Lewis (Director at Large) reported that the Waggin' Tales deadline is Sunday, August 18th.

Old Business

 Wendy announced that the cost of the Taurine Clinic is \$100.00, not \$91.00 as currently listed on the club's website. Carolyn Pearson will verify that the PDF version of the announcement is correct and if not, modify it. Dave Lewis will modify the announcement on the club's website. Wendy Waddick will confirm with Donna Bihner that all of the information is correct.

New Business

Wendy reported that she had received an email message from a Board Certified canine massage
therapist who was interested in offering to teach several different types of canine massage classes
during training nights at Fox Valley Dog Training Club. Following the discussion, it was determined that
Wendy would contact the Kane County Fairgrounds to determine whether we could rent the kitchen to
host the classes. Their response would determine our next steps.

A motion was made, seconded and approved to adjourn the meeting at 8:41 p.m.

Board Meeting Highlights - October 09, 2019

Meeting brought to order at 7:50 p.m.

Carolyn Pearson (Secretary). The June Meeting minutes were approved as published.

Bob Boeke (First Vice-President) made a motion to purchase a new bar jump from J&J Dog Supplies for \$191.00 to replace the jump used in the Rally Run-through ring and to be used during the club's annual trials. During the discussion, the Acme Manufacturing and the MAX200 websites were reviewed to investigate other jumps. Acme, no longer makes obedience equipment and the MAX200 jumps were higher priced. Dave Lewis seconded the motion, the motion passed without any objections or abstentions.

Carolyn also confirmed that the "bring your own shop vac" event is confirmed for November 12th at 7:00 p.m. Bob stated that he and Ed will have the mats in from the external shed, so that they can be vacuumed too.

Carla Tsoris (Second Vice-President) stated that she is working with the Naperville Fire Dept. to perform a Pet CPR demonstration/class, tentatively in March, 2020. It was also mentioned that the local Red Cross might still offer classes.

Carla reported that the FVDTC volunteers who attended the Caldwell Banks Pet Adoption event did not have any club signage or any identifying information for the club. She also said that the attendees did not appear to have any directions as to what they were expected to do at the event. It suggested that perhaps the club should consider getting logo'd name-tags for the volunteers at various events; Sue MacPherson stated that she recently ordered name-tags for her work and would provide that information to the Board.

Phil Nuger (Treasurer) was not in attendance but sent the YTD financials. He stated that he included a portion in the report that groups the income and expenses by classes. For example, agility trial income and expenses are grouped together. He also asked the Board to consider withdrawing the CD from Old Second when it matures in November and moving the money to the investment account. Phil reported that the investment strategy, as originally presented by Morgan Stanley, allocated 20% - 30% to be invested in low risk/return CDs and similar investments. These funds would go towards that element of the strategy and Morgan Stanley has more CD choices and generally offers a better rate of return than Old Second has given us over the last few years.

Dave Lewis made a motion to withdraw the money from the maturing CD at Old Second and moved to the investment account at Morgan Stanley. Will Short seconded the motion, the motion passed without any objections or abstentions.

Will Short (Director of Training) reported that the instructors have been confirmed for the next session as well as the rotating instructors in the drop-in classes.

Wendy stated that we need to get someone new for the information table that can be there throughout the night. The individual or team must be able to guarantee 100% coverage from 6:00 pm until 8:30 pm.

Old Business

By-Law Change - Junior Membership
 It was agreed that the new Junior Membership type should be eligible to be applied towards the 15 consecutive years of membership required for Lifetime Membership. The addition of the Junior Membership to the By-laws will be presented during the November membership meeting for voting.

New Business

 Wendy reported that a Waubonsee Community College teacher has asked for permission for some students to observe the classes during training nights as a part of the Begin Your Career as a Professional Dog Trainer I curriculum.

A motion was made, seconded and approved to adjourn the meeting at 9:16 p.m.

IT'S A WARDS TIME 2019!

Congratulations! If you are filling out award forms then you must have earned one or more new titles in 2019! It is the policy of FVDTC to give awards for AKC, CKC and UKC titles earned at trials, tests or shows each year. To receive a club award, you must have a total of 10 work credits for the year and be listed as a Regular Training Member in the Roster. If for some reason you have not met **ALL** your requirements and can justify the reason, your eligibility will be reviewed by the Board of Directors.

Contained is this packet is a form for individual awards, as well an application for the club's Special Awards. Please review each item in the following list before you begin.

- Each form must be completely filled out and **please print clearly** so we can read your information.
- Please submit **one** Family/Individual Work Credit Form plus **one** Award Application Form for **each** dog. If Spot and Fido each earned a title, then two Award Applications should be submitted with one Work Credit Form.
- Work credits can be earned by anyone in the family.
- A dog is limited to receiving one AKC award per level of titles received. For example, if your dog earns a CD and an RA, you may pick only one award at Level 2. The exception to this, is anyone who receives a title at the highest level in the same year (OTCH and a MACH).
- Awards are given for titles earned in 2019 (i.e., a dog may have earned two "legs" toward a title prior to 2016, but if the third "leg" was earned in 2018, the title is earned in 2018). However, all scores for any of the "Special Club Awards" must have been earned in 2019.
- Please print clearly on the 2019 FVDTC Annual Awards form. The Awards Committee wants your awards to be correct, so a clearly filled out form will help the committee achieve that goal.

PLEASE NOTE:

All photos submitted for an award MUST be <u>clear</u> and <u>close-up and should be emailed, actual prints are usually not</u> <u>necessary</u>. Airbrushed awards by Bill McGuffey require an article of clothing, which must be no less than 50% cotton and must be washed at least once. The clothing cannot have pleats, seams or sewn-in folds where the picture is to be painted. All of our artists need time to provide their best work, therefore the submission deadline will NOT be extended. PLEASE be considerate and meet or beat the deadline.
