IT'S AWARDS TIME 2020!

Congratulations! If you are filling out award forms then you must have earned one or more new titles in 2020! It is the policy of FVDTC to give awards for AKC, CKC and UKC titles earned at trials, tests or shows each year. To receive a club award, you must have a total of **5** work credits for the year and be listed as a Regular Training Member in the Roster. If for some reason you have not met **ALL** your requirements and can justify the reason, your eligibility will be reviewed by the Board of Directors.

Contained is this packet is a form for individual awards, as well an application for the club's Special Awards. Please review each item in the following list before you begin.

- Each form must be completely filled out and **please** print clearly so we can read your information.
- Please submit **one** Family/Individual Work Credit Form plus **one** Award Application Form for **each** dog. If Spot and Fido each earned a title, then two Award Applications should be submitted with one Work Credit Form.
- Work credits can be earned by anyone in the family.
- <u>A dog is limited to receiving one AKC award per level of titles received</u>. For example, if your dog earns a CD and an RA, you may pick only one award at Level 2. The exception to this, is anyone who receives a title at the highest level in the same year (OTCH and a MACH).
- Awards are given for titles earned in 2020 (i.e., a dog may have earned two "legs" toward a title prior to 2020, but if the third "leg" was earned in 2020, the title is earned in 2020). However, <u>all scores for any of the "Special Club Awards" must have been earned in 2020.</u>
- Please print clearly on the 2020 FVDTC Annual Awards form. The Awards Committee wants your awards to be correct, so a clearly filled out form will help the committee achieve that goal.

PLEASE NOTE:

All photos submitted for an award MUST be <u>clear</u> and <u>close-up and should be emailed, actual prints are usually not</u> <u>necessary</u>. Airbrushed awards by Bill McGuffey require an article of clothing, which must be no less than 50% cotton and must be washed at least once. The clothing cannot have pleats, seams or sewn-in folds where the picture is to be painted. All of our artists need time to provide their best work, therefore the submission deadline will NOT be extended. PLEASE be considerate and meet or beat the deadline.

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Board Meeting Highlights - October 14, 2020

Meeting brought to order at 7:35 p.m.

Carolyn Pearson (Secretary) There were no meeting minutes to approve.

Phil Nuger (Treasurer) reported that due to the lack of breakdown and set-up expenses, the club is saving money. Phil stated that the three-day (1 trial per day) 2019 Fall Agility Trial showed a profit of \$3,000 and the two-day (2 trials per day) 2020 Fall Agility Trial showed a profit of \$4,000.

FVDTC's financial position remains very strong. Cash and investment account balances have both increased. Value of investment account continues to fluctuate with the market. Current value is up \$5,000 over 2019 end of year valuation.

Phil distributed the Statement of Activity Comparison between 2019 and 2020, for January through October with the following information:

- Income Statement
- Book asset balances,
- Agility Trial breakdown (\$8,013 net income)
- Tracking Trial breakdown (\$515 loss)

Will Short (Director of Training) reported that two students in the 8:00 Puppy Class tested positive for COVID. However, it was confirmed that the exposure occurred after their Thursday class.

In response to Dave's question about the procedure we should follow in this event, Sue suggested that we contact the County Health Department to determine the procedure they recommend. Phil stated that he contacted the CDC following a report that one of his employees was exposed to COVID, and they stated that protocol is to quarantine the employee for 14 days. They recommended that the employee show a negative COVID test result in order to return to work. Wendy stated that she will contact Vera Nyberg with the process to follow with the students and share the information with Will Short.

Taffy Wille (Obedience Trial Chairperson) reported the following:

- COVID guidelines have been released and posted.
- Kitchen Committee and Hospitality Chairs are in search of a box lunch supplier for the workers and judges.
- Workers are being scheduled.
- Counts are extremely low may need to consider cancelling the trial to avoid a huge loss.
 - As of Friday's mail (10/9/20) Saturday Obedience trial had a total of 54 entries. Each of Saturday's Rally Trials had about 25 entries (29 Trial 1, 25 Trial 2). Sunday Obedience trial had 58 entries and the Sunday Rally Trial had 23 entries.
 - The cost of the building for the weekend, the judges' expenses/fees and cost of hospitality should be considered in regarding to continuing to hold the trial. At what point do we make this decision?

Dave Lewis (Director at Large) reported that the class sign-up application failed recently due to the lack of future calendar dates. The issue has been resolved.

Old Business

 Carolyn asked the Board to re-address the COVID-based restriction of allowing instructors to do a Stand-For-Exam (SFE), the Conformation exam and the ability for instructors to assist dogs during the Recall exercise. She suggested that (with the permission of each handler) the SFE could be done with the following method; prior to the exam, the instructor would apply hand-sanitizer, then examine the dog with one hand and then examine the next dog with the other hand; then would apply more hand-sanitizer before examining the next two dogs.

For the Recall exercise, Carolyn suggested that the instructor be allowed to assist the handler during the recall by either stepping on the leash or holding the leash after applying hand-sanitizer. After much discussion, it was agreed that performing those exercises in a manner similar to that described, would be consistent with the current CDC COVID guidelines.
